- ❖ ICICI Bank has entered into an exclusive partnership with 'Amazon Pay' to launch a co-branded credit card, 'Amazon Pay ICICI Bank Credit Card'.

New SBI ATM withdrawal limits to come into effect

- ❖ The new ATM cash withdrawal rules for SBI account holders will come into effect from today, October 31, 2018.
- ❖ The country's largest bank will reduce the daily cash withdrawal limit for Classic and Maestro debit cards to Rs 20,000 per day, from Rs 40,000.

Government approves construction of over two lakh additional houses in urban areas under PMAY

- ❖ The government has approved the construction of over two lakh additional houses in urban areas under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana.
- ❖ An official release said West Bengal has been sanctioned over one lakh affordable houses and Uttar Pradesh more than 50,000 houses.
- ❖ Andhra Pradesh has been sanctioned over 41,000 houses and Maharashtra over 20,000. Further, over 1,400 houses have been sanctioned for Nagaland and around 500 houses for Dadra and Nagar Haveli.

Union Transport Minister to lay the foundation for India's largest Dry Dock

- ❖ The foundation stone for India's largest Dry Dock will be laid by Union Transport Minister Nitin Gadkari and Kerala Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan at Cochin Shipyard in Kerala on October 30, 2018.
- ❖ The Dry Dock will give a major boost to the "Make in India" initiative under Sagarmala and raise India's share in global shipbuilding to 2 percent. India currently occupies 0.66 per cent share in global shipbuilding market.

Supreme Court prohibits plying of 15-year-old petrol, 10-year-old diesel vehicles in Delhi-NCR

- ❖ The Supreme Court prohibited the plying of 15-year-old petrol and 10-year-old diesel vehicles in the Delhi-NCR (national capital region) in a move to deal with the prevailing "very critical" and "horrible" pollution situation in Delhi-NCR.
- ❖ A bench of Justices Madan B Lokur, S Abdul Nazeer and Deepak Gupta also clarified that such vehicles would be seized, if found on roads in Delhi-NCR.

Fifth National Summit on Public Health Care held

- ❖ The 5th National Summit on Good and Replicable Practices and Innovations in Public Health Care Systems in India began in Kaziranga, Assam.
- ❖ Addressing the summit Union Health Minister J P Nadda stressed on perform, reform and transform as emphasised by Prime Minister.

Reserve Bank of India gives licence to Kirloskar Capital

- ❖ Kirloskar Capital, the non-banking financial company, has received the Reserve Bank of India's licence for its lending business. The move assumes significance at a time when the whole non-banking sector has been going through a crisis of confidence.
- ❖ The Kirloskar group has more than 30,000 retailers and about 1,000 dealers, who will be leveraged – especially for SME loan.

GST collections cross Rs one lakh crore mark

- ❖ Revenue collections under the Goods and Services Tax (GST) crossed the Rs 1 lakh crore mark in October.
- ❖ This was a marked improvement over the September GST collection (for August) which stood at Rs 94,442 crore.

- ❖ The only other time the GST collections had crossed the Rs 1 lakh crore mark was in April (for the month of March) when it was attributed to it being the last month of the financial year when collections are usually high “as people also try to pay arrears of some previous months”.

ICICI Bank Launches Instant Digital Credit Facility for Small Payments “PayLater”

- ❖ India-based banking group ICICI Bank announced the launch of its instant digital credit facility, PayLater, which was created to enable customers small-ticket ticketitems immediately in a completely digital and paperless manner.
- ❖ The launch of this new feature was announced days after ICICI Bank announced the launch of its new co-branded credit card with Amazon.
- ❖ According to ICICI Bank, the facility enables customers to shop online, pay bills and pay to any merchant UPI ID at physical stores instantly. The fintech noted that this facility leverages upon the technology unveiled in BHIM UPI 2.0 to extend digital credit to customers for making payments using UPI.

IIT-Madras creates ‘Shakti’, India’s first microprocessor

- ❖ India’s first indigenous microprocessor may soon power your mobile phones, surveillance cameras and smart meters.
- ❖ ‘Shakti’, designed, developed and booted by Indian Institute of Technology Madras, and with a microchip fabricated in the Semi-Conductor Laboratory of Indian Space Research Organisation (Isro) at Chandigarh, will reduce dependency on imported microchips and the risk of cyber attacks making it ideal for communication and defence sectors.

India-Japan military exercise begins in Mizoram

- ❖ Armies of India and Japan began their first-ever joint military exercise on November 1 at a jungle warfare school in Mizoram’s Vairengte with a focus on strengthening counter-terror cooperation.
- ❖ The focus of the two-week-long exercise ‘Dharma Guardian-2018’ will be to enhance tactical skills against global terrorism and increase inter-operability between the two forces.

KJ Alphons presides over the Program and Budget Committee meeting of UNWTO

- ❖ The Minister of State for Tourism, KJ Alphons along with a delegation of senior officials attended the 109th session of United Nations World Tourism Organization (UNWTO) Executive Council in Manama, Bahrain.
- ❖ The three day Session of UNWTO Executive Council began on October 30, 2018.
- ❖ Alphons chaired the ‘Programme and Budget Committee’ meeting of UNWTO.
- ❖ The Minister highlighted the role of tourism in socio-economic development through job creation, enterprise and environment development and foreign exchange earnings.
- ❖ As the chair of the Committee, the Minister informed the session that for the first time,UNWTO had a surplus budget and most of the arrears due have been paid.
- ❖ India will be the chair of Programme and Budget Committee of UNWTO Executive Council till 2021.

Cabinet approves signing of MoU between India and S Korea

- ❖ The Cabinet has approved the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding between India and South Korea.
- ❖ The main objective of the MoU is to expand bilateral cooperation in tourism and to increase the exchange of information and data related to the sector.

SS Deswal appointed as Director General of Indo-Tibetan Border Police

- ❖ The Appointments Committee of the Cabinet (ACC) appointed senior IPS officer S S Deswal as Director General of Indo-Tibetan Border Police (ITBP).
- ❖ He will succeed R K Pachnanda, who superannuated from office.

Delhi government, Indian Railways sign MoU for Mukhyamantri Tirth Yatra Yojana

- ❖ The Delhi government signed a memorandum of understanding with the railway to cater to pilgrims availing the Mukhyamantri Tirth Yatra Yojana,
- ❖ It stated the MoU was inked by officials of the Delhi government and the railways in the presence of Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia at the Delhi Secretariat in New Delhi.

Kerala signs MoU for implementation of Ayushman Bharat

- ❖ The Kerala government signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with the National Health Agency on November 1 for the implementation of the Centre's flagship health insurance scheme — Ayushman Bharat- Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana Abhiyan (ABPMJAY)

CJI establishes in-house 'Think Tank' for research & planning

- ❖ The Chief Justice of India Ranjan Gogi established an in house 'think tank' to strengthen the knowledge infrastructure of Supreme Court of India.
- ❖ To this end, the CJI redefined the mandate of Centre for Research and Planning (CRP) to meet the "fast expanding knowledge needs of judiciary".
- ❖ The main mandate of the think tank would be to carry out cutting edge research into "fundamental jurisprudence and principles and doctrines of law" as well as on "judicial reforms" for improvement in "justice delivery" and "judicial independence".

ICICI Bank organises 60 coin exchange 'melas' across Goa

- ❖ ICICI Bank recently organised over 60 coin exchange 'melas' at its select branches across Goa.
- ❖ According to a statement here on Thursday, the 'melas' were held under the aegis of the Reserve Bank of India (RBI).
- ❖ The purpose of the 'melas' were to distribute coins and fresh currency notes to the general public in exchange of soiled and mutilated notes.
- ❖ The initiative was in line with RBI's Clean Note Policy.
- ❖ Carey Mascarenhas, Assistant General Manager, Reserve Bank of India, inaugurated the coin 'mela' at the Panaji branch.

PM Modi launches support, outreach programme for MSME; announces series of measures to spur growth in the sec

- ❖ Prime Minister Narendra Modi has said that every GST registered Micro, Small and Medium Enterprise, MSME, will be given a rebate of 2 percent interest on the amount of a new loan or incremental loan up to one crore rupees.
- ❖ Announcing a series of measures during the launch of MSME Support and Outreach Programme in New Delhi this evening, Mr Modi said, the government has also decided to increase interest subvention on pre and post shipment credit for exports by MSMEs from 3 per cent to 5 per cent.
- ❖ loan of up to one crore rupees will be sanctioned for MSME sector in 59-minutes. Mr Modi said, all the companies which have a turnover above 500 million, will now be required to bring them on Trade Receivables e-Discounting System, so that MSMEs do not have problems in cash flow.

Atul Goel takes over as MD, CEO of UCO Bank

- ❖ Atul Kumar Goel Friday assumed charge as Managing Director and CEO of UCO Bank.

- ❖ Prior to this assignment, he was executive director of Union Bank of India. Goel takes over from R K Takkar who completed his three-year tenure on November 1, 2018.
Justices Hemant Gupta, R Subhash Reddy, MR Shah and Ajay Rastogi sworn-in as Supreme Court Judges
- ❖ Justices Hemant Gupta, R Subhash Reddy, M R Shah and Ajay Rastogi were on November 2, 2018 sworn-in as the Judges of the Supreme Court. Chief Justice Ranjan Gogoi administered oath of office to the four judges.
- ❖ Justice Gupta served as the Chief Justice of the Madhya Pradesh High Court; Justice Rastogi as the Chief Justice of the Tripura High Court; Justice Shah as the incumbent Chief Justice of the Patna High Court; and Justice Reddy as the Chief Justice of the Gujarat High Court.
China launches new high-orbit satellite BeiDou-3
- ❖ China successfully launched a high orbit satellite BeiDou-3 to boost BeiDou global satellite navigation system being built to rival United States Global Position System (GPS).
VP Venkaiah Naidu launches 'Yoga And Mindfulness' by Mansi Gulati
- ❖ The book was launched by the Vice President of India, M. Venkaiah Naidu amidst the presence of Member of Parliament from the Rajya Sabha, Dr. Sonal Mansingh, Member of Parliament from the Lok Sabha Manoj Tewari, at Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel Conference Hall, Vice President's House.
Banks get RBI nod to raise credit to NBFC bonds
- ❖ In a move that could provide some liquidity to the cash-starved non-banking financial companies (NBFC), the RBI on Friday allowed banks to raise credit to bonds issued by the systemically important NBFCs and housing finance companies (HFCs).
- ❖ Credit enhancements have been allowed for corporate bonds for the infrastructure sector but there weren't many takers for this, said bond arrangers. Through such an arrangement, credit of the issue gets enhanced as banks take responsibility of a part of the issue.
- ❖ This enables corporates to access funds from the bond market on better terms.
- ❖ Under RBI rules, a bank can provide credit enhancements to the tune of 20 per cent of the bond size, for entities rated BBB or better.
India to extend USD 310 million loan for Zimbabwe power plant
- ❖ India on Saturday announced that it would extend a USD 310 million loan to Zimbabwe to finance a rehabilitation project for a thermal power plant that would entail upgrading the station and extending its lifespan.
India and Japan for the first time to cooperate in Yoga, Ayurveda
- ❖ India and Japan on Monday decided to cooperate for the first time in the areas of Indian traditional medicinal systems such as Yoga and Ayurveda to provide holistic healthcare and wellness in both the countries.
Manipur hosts 1st Northeast Olympic Games
- ❖ Players of national and international level geared up for the first-ever Northeast Olympic Games in Manipur's host city Imphal.
- ❖ Organized by the Manipur Olympic Association under the aegis of Northeast Olympic Association, the championship acted as a platform for the players to showcase and nurture their talent in different sports discipline.
India ranked 12 globally in web-borne threats: Kaspersky Lab
- ❖ Globally, India ranks 12th when it comes to the dangers associated with surfing the web, according to a new report from Russia-based global cybersecurity firm Kaspersky Lab.

- ❖ **SBI, Hitachi form JV to boost digital payments, card acceptance platforms**
Country's largest lender State Bank of India (SBI) and Japan's Hitachi will enter into a joint venture (JV) for establishing card acceptance and digital payments platform in India.
- ❖ **Indian Railways is building world's highest railway line in Ladakh**
Indian railways plans to connect New Delhi with Ladakh region through the world's highest railway line that will run along the India-China border. The national transporter plans to build a strategically-important Bilaspur-Manali- Leh line along the Indo-China border.
- ❖ The rail line will have a highest road point of 5,360 metres above mean sea level that is comparable only to the Qinghai-Tibet Railway Line in China, which is at a height of around 2,000 metres.
- ❖ **Union Minister Suresh Prabhu inaugurated the 10th Edition of BIOFACH INDIA**
Hon'ble Union Minister for Commerce and Industry, Suresh Prabhu inaugurated the 10th Edition of BIOFACH INDIA, the largest show on the "Organic Sector" in India.
- ❖ **India donates 3 lakh Dollars for peacekeeping initiative at UN**
India has donated three lakh Dollars for a peacekeeping initiative at the UN. The programme will help develop the capacity of future commanders and managers over a period of three years.
- ❖ The UN Department of Field Support announced that the Indian government donated the amount for the 'Pipeline to Peacekeeping Command Programme' with a specific focus on issues of conduct and discipline.
- ❖ **Justice Bopanna Sworn In As Chief Justice Of Gauhati High Court**
Justice Ajjikkuttira Somaiah Bopanna, a judge of the Karnataka High Court, was sworn in as the new Chief Justice of the Gauhati High Court
- ❖ **Michael D Higgins re-elected as Irish president for second term**
Michael D Higgins has been re-elected as the President of Ireland after receiving 56 percent of the country's votes in the elections. Businessman Peter Casey came second with 23.1 per cent votes, while none of the other four candidates polled more than 10 per cent,
- ❖ **Jair Bolsonaro wins Brazil's Presidential election**
Far-right candidate Jair Bolsonaro was 2018 declared as the winner of Brazil's 2018 Presidential Elections by a wide margin. Bolsonaro swept the election results with 55.1 per cent of the votes cast, as against 44.8 per cent votes of his opponent, Fernando Haddad from the left-wing Workers' Party (PT).
- ❖ **Vigilance awareness week to be observed**
