

India inks an agreement with NABCONS bank for setting up India-Africa Institute of Agriculture & Rural Development in Malawi

- India on Tuesday signed an agreement with a development bank for setting up IndiaAfrica Institute of Agriculture and Rural Development (IAIARD) in Malawi.
- In a statement, the Ministry of External Affairs said it has signed an MoU with National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development Consultancy Service, NABCONS for setting up the Institute.
- The agreement is a part of India's efforts to enhance capacity in the areas of agro-financing and entrepreneurship development for African countries. IAIARD will be a Pan-African Institute wherein trainees not only from Malawi but also from other African countries, will receive training to develop their human resources and build their capacity.
- The entire expenditure on faculty from India, the travel, logistics and training course expenses for students from other African countries will be borne by the Government of India for an initial period of three years.

RBI to inject USD 5 billion more liquidity into banking system

- The Reserve Bank of India will inject long-term liquidity worth USD 5 billion into the banking system through a dollar-rupee buy-sell swap for tenure of three years on April 23, 2019.
- The move is aimed at meeting the durable liquidity needs of the system. The swap will be in the nature of a simple buy-sell foreign exchange swap from the Reserve Bank side. Under the swap, a bank would sell US dollars to the RBI and simultaneously agree to buy the same amount of US dollars at the end of the swap period.
- The auction would be a multiple-price based auction in which successful bids will get accepted at their respective quoted premium.

India, Chile sign MoU, release Joint Statement

- India and Chile released a Joint Statement after extensive talks between Indian President Ram Nath Kovind and the President of Chile, Sebastian Pinera Echenique, during the former's official state visit to Chile from March 30 to April 1, 2019.
- This is the third leg of the President's three-nation tour which included Croatia and Bolivia. The Indian President paid an official visit to the South American nation at the invitation of the Chilean President.
- The visit highlights the commemoration of the 70th anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic relations between Chile and India.

NCR districts switch to Euro-VI grade fuels (BS-VI fuels)

- The supply of ultra-clean Euro-VI grade fuel (also known as Bharat Stage VI grade fuel) began in cities adjoining the National Capital Region (NCR) on April 1, 2019. Several cities in the 12 neighboring districts of Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh including Agra switched over to the cleaner fuel.
- The Bharat Stage VI grade fuel, both petrol and diesel containing 10 parts per million (ppm), is being supplied in Alwar, Bharatpur, Karauli and Dholpur in Rajasthan and Meerut, Muzaffarnagar, Ghaziabad, Gautam Budh Nagar, Baghpat, Hapur, Bulandshahr, Shamli and Agra in Uttar Pradesh.

'Disturbed Area' tag extended for 3 Arunachal districts

- The Union Ministry of Home Affairs extended the "disturbed area" tag under the Armed Forces Special Powers Act (AFSPA) for three districts of Arunachal Pradesh for another six months.
- These 3 districts are **Tirap, Changlang and Longding**. "Disturbed Area" tag partly removed from three other districts of Arunachal Pradesh.
- The Government withdrew the "disturbed area" tag partly from three other districts bordering Assam including Namsai, Lower Dibang Valley and Lohit district.

US approves sale of 24 MH 60 Romeo Seahawk helicopters to India

- The Trump administration has approved the sale of 24 multi-role MH-60 Romeo Seahawk helicopters to India at an estimated cost of 2.4 billion US dollars, the State .
- It is considered the world's most advanced maritime helicopter. The choppers will provide the Indian defence forces with the capability to perform anti-surface and anti-submarine warfare missions.

Japan names new imperial era as 'Reiwa'

- Japan on April 1, 2019 declared 'Reiwa' as the name of its new imperial era that will begin on May 1, 2019 once the new Crown Prince Naruhito ascends the Chrysanthemum Throne.
- Crown Prince Naruhito will succeed his father Emperor Akihito, who will abdicate the empire on April 30, 2019, putting an end to three decades long 'Heisei' era. The new era will be the 248th in the history of Japan.
- The announcement regarding the same was made by Japanese Chief Cabinet Secretary Yoshihide Suga.

Bolivia joins International Solar Alliance

- During the state visit of the President Ram Nath Kovind to Bolivia, Bolivia signed the framework agreement to join the International Solar Alliance.
- The ISA is a major initiative of Prime Minister Narendra Modi in contributing to the implementation of the Paris Climate Agreement through the rapid and massive deployment of solar energy.
- The International Solar Alliance was launched jointly by Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi and French President Francois Hollande on the first day of the COP-21 summit at Paris in 2015.

Estonia tops in E-voting with 44% of online votes

- Estonia has emerged as a global leader in online voting with 44% of votes in the recently concluded parliamentary elections in the country.
- Centre-Right Reform Party emerged victorious with 40% of the e-votes and nearly 30% of the total votes. A large number (25%) of e-votes were cast by people over the age of 55, while 20% were cast by people aged between 45 to 54 years. With total 1.3 million of population, 5,61,131 were the total voters while 2,47,232 people preferred for online voting.

India retains ICC Test Championship mace for third consecutive year

- India have retained the ICC Test Championship Mace and won the purse of USD 1 million for a third successive year on April 1, 2019.
- India won this award after finishing at the top of the MRF Tyres ICC Test Team Rankings on the cut-off date of April 1, while New Zealand have ensured second place. International Cricket Council chief executive Manu Sawhney congratulated the Indian team while reiterating the importance of Test cricket and looking forward to the start of the ICC World Test Championship later this year.

India Finish with 16 gold medals at Asian Airgun Championships

Indian shooters continued their dominance claiming five gold medals on the final day of the Asian Airgun Championships to sign off with a total of 25 medals in Taoyuan, Taipei. India finished with 16 gold, five silver and four bronze medals. The next assignment for Indian shooters is scheduled at Al Ain, the United Arab Emirates where the International Shooting Sport Federation Shotgun World Cup.

Sohail Mahmood, High Commissioner to India, Appointed as Pakistan's Foreign Secretary

- Pakistan's High Commissioner to India and seasoned diplomat Sohail Mahmood will be the country's new foreign secretary, Foreign Minister Shah Mahmood Qureshi announced.

India likely to grow at 7.2% in current fiscal year: ADB

- Asian Development Bank, ADB, says India's growth is set to pick up. In its report rele.
- ADB said India is expected to grow at 7.2 per cent in the current fiscal on strengthening consumption. According to the Asian Development Outlook 2019, India's growth slowed from 7.2 per cent in fiscal 2017 to 7 per cent in 2018, with weaker agricultural output and consumption growth curtailed by higher global oil prices and lower government expenditure.
- It is expected to rebound to 7.2 per cent in 2019 and 7.3 per cent in 2020 as policy rates are cut and farmers receive income support, bolstering domestic demand. The report added that sub-region wise, southeast Asia will sustain growth at close to 5 per cent this year and the next one.

Reliance Jio Digital Services acquires AI firm Haptik in Rs 700 cr-deal

- Reliance Jio Digital Services has acquired artificial intelligence firm Haptik in a Rs 700 crore deal.

- Reliance will hold about 87 per cent of the business with the rest being held by Haptik founders and employees through stock option grants.
- The business transfer agreement has been signed by Reliance Jio Digital Services Limited with Haptik Infotech Pvt Ltd (Haptik). Founded in 2013, Haptik is chat-based virtual concierge mobile application.

Bilateral Maritime Exercise 'AUSINDEX-19' begins

- The third edition of 'AUSINDEX-19' (Australia India Exercise), bilateral maritime exercise between Indian Navy and Royal Australian Navy, began on April 2, 2019 with the arrival of Royal Australian Navy's fleet at Visakhapatnam.

Indian Army built longest suspension bridge at Leh in just 40 days

- The Indian Army has successfully built the longest suspension bridge 'Maitri Bridge' over the Indus River in the Leh-Ladakh region.
- It is the shortest time of Indian Army built any suspension bridge of this length. Suspension Bridge constructed over Indus River by Combat Engineers 'Fire & Fury Corps' was inaugurated by local War Veterans of region on April 1, 2019. Built in a record time of 40 days 'Maitri Bridge' is longest Suspension Bridge over Indus River.

South Korea to launch world's first national 5G network

- South Korea would be launching the world's first fully-fledged 5G mobile networks on .
- Hyper-Wired South Korea has a reputation for technical prowess and it has made the 5G rollout a priority as it seeks to stimulate stuttering economic growth.
- The superfast communications heralded by fifth-generation wireless technology will bring smartphones near-instantaneous connectivity – 20 times faster than the existing 4G.

ICC to join hands with Interpol to fight corruption in sport

- The International Cricket Council (ICC) has sought closer working relations with the Interpol to widen the scope of its fight against corruption in the sport.
- The cooperation was discussed during ICC Anti-Corruption Unit General Manager, Alex Marshall's visit to the Interpol headquarters in Lyon, France.
- In a press notification, Marshall said that the ICC and Interpol are keen on working together and the meetings in Lyon last week were productive.

First Bi-monthly Monetary Policy Statement 2019-20: RBI cuts Repo Rate to 6%

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) on April 4, 2019 released its First Bi-monthly Monetary Policy Statement 2019-20.
After assessing the current and evolving macroeconomic situation in the economy, the six member-Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) decided to:
- Reduce the policy Repo Rate under the liquidity adjustment facility (LAF) by 25 basis points to 6 percent from 6.25 percent with immediate effect.
- Consequently, the Reverse Repo Rate under the LAF stands adjusted to 5.75 percent The Marginal Standing Facility (MSF) rate and the Bank Rate stand at 6.25 percent.
- The MPC also decided to maintain the neutral monetary policy stance. The MPC voted 4:2 in favour of the 25 basis point cut. The decision of the MPC was in consonance with the objective of achieving the medium-term target for Consumer Price Index (CPI) inflation of 4 percent within a band of +/- 2 percent.
- The committee projected GDP growth of 7.2 percent in the financial year 2019-20.

BSE, India INX become first Indian exchanges to sign MoU with Moscow Exchange

- BSE (earlier known as Bombay Stock Exchange) and India International Exchange (India INX) have signed a memorandum of understanding with Moscow Exchange (MOEX) to connect investor community and companies in both countries besides allowing a capital formation platform.
- BSE and India INX are the first Indian exchanges to enter into the MoU with Moscow exchange.

UAE honours PM Narendra Modi with Zayed Medal

- The United Arab Emirates (UAE) honoured PM Narendra Modi with its highest decoration, Zayed Medal in recognition of his "pivotal role" in strengthening ties between the two nations.

- The Zayed Medal is the highest decoration of the UAE awarded to kings, presidents and heads of states.

International Mine Awareness Day observed

- International Mine Awareness Day was observed across the world on 4 April, 2019. The theme of International Mine Awareness Day 2019 was “United Nations Promotes SDGs – Safe Ground – Safe Home”.

National Maritime Day observed

- India celebrates National Maritime Day on 5 April which is dedicated to country’s glorious maritime history.
- The theme of the National Maritime Day 2019 celebrations is “Indian Ocean-An Ocean of opportunity”.

ADB publishes Asian Development Outlook 2019

- Asian Development Bank (ADB) has published its ‘Asian Development Outlook 2019’ report on April 3, 2019. Growth in developing Asia is projected to soften to 5.7% in 2019 and 5.6% in 2020.
- Excluding Asia’s high-income newly industrialized economies, growth is expected to slip from 6.4% in 2018 to 6.2% in 2019 and 6.1% in 2020. As per the ADB report, since oil prices rose and Asian currencies depreciated, inflation edged up last year but remained low by historical standards. In light of stable commodity prices, inflation is anticipated to remain subdued at 2.5% in both 2019 and 2020.
- ADB has cut India’s growth forecast to 7.2% for 2019-20 because of a slower-than-expected pickup in investment demand.
- The growth rate in Financial Year 2020-21 is likely to be 7.3%. Growth in India is forecast to pick up a bit to 7.2% in 2019 and 7.3% in 2020 on recovery in agriculture and stronger domestic demand, with reform having strengthened the health of banks and corporations, and as the implementation of a value-added tax makes domestic firms and products more competitive.

Health Ministry forms a Human Chain towards Universal Health Care

- The Union Ministry of Health and Family Welfare along with the World Health Organisation (WHO) on April 4, 2019 formed a Solidarity Human Chain as part of the ‘World Health Day 2019’ celebrations to reaffirm their commitment towards Universal Health Coverage (UHC).
- The theme of World Health Day 2019 is ‘Universal Health Coverage: Everyone, Everywhere’.

Praful Patel becomes first Indian to be elected as member of FIFA Executive Council

- Praful Patel, the President of All India Football Federation has become the first Indian to be elected as a member of the FIFA Executive Council. He received 38 out of 46 votes.

David Malpass named new World Bank president

- Senior US Treasury official David Malpass was unanimously chosen as the new President of the World Bank. The announcement came as expected just prior to next week’s joint spring meeting of the World Bank and the IMF.

Vikram Kirloskar takes charge as CII President

- Vikram Kirloskar on April 6, 2019 took charge as the new President of the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII). Kirloskar is the Chairman and Managing Director of Kirloskar Systems Ltd and Vice Chairman of Toyota Kirloskar Motor.

Actor Shah Rukh Khan received honorary doctorate from The University of Law, London

- Shah Rukh Khan received honorary doctorate in Philanthropy from The University of Law, London. The actor received the merit during a graduation ceremony of more than 350 students held at the Barbican in London.

FIFA rankings: Belgium tops, India gets 101st rank

- FIFA has released world football rankings. India rose two points and gets 101st rank while Belgium tops the list.

- FIFA said in its report, there were 150 games played across the globe during the international period, things remain tight at the top of the FIFA World Ranking as the top three remained unchanged.
- In current FIFA rankings India gained two spots, but couldn't found a space in top 100. As per latest FIFA rankings India is on 101st position while 18th in the Asia.
