

Government notifies taking over of National Housing Bank from RBI

- The government has issued a notification taking over the National Housing Bank (NHB) after buying entire stake for ₹1,450 crore from the Reserve Bank of India (RBI).
- The RBI has exited the NHB, thus making it a fully government-owned entity. The central bank was holding 100% stake in the NHB, the housing finance regulator.
- The move is part of ending the cross-holding in regulatory institutions and follows the recommendation of Narasimham-II committee report of October 2001 and the RBI's own discussion paper on the same, titled 'Harmonising the Role and Operations of Development Financial Institutions and Banks'.

NCLT approved merger of IndusInd Bank and BFIL

- The National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT) approved the merger of IndusInd Bank with Bharat Financial Inclusion (BFIL). The merger will be completed within 2-4 weeks.
- Post-merger, the BFIL will become a subsidiary of the IndusInd Bank. Bharat Financial Inclusion Limited is a Non-Banking Finance Company, licensed by the Reserve Bank of India.

India-US enter agreement to check tax evasion by MNCs

- India has notified the inter-governmental agreement with the US for exchange of country-by-country (CbC) reports on multinational companies regarding income allocation and taxes paid in order to help check cross-border tax evasion.
- The agreement, which was signed by Central Board of Direct Taxes Chairman P C Mody and US ambassador to India Kenneth Juster in March, was notified by the revenue department.

Nirmala Sitharaman attends SCO Defence Ministers' conclave at Bishkek

- The Shanghai Co-operation Organisation (SCO) Defence Ministers' conclave was held at Bishkek in Kyrgyzstan on April 29, 2019.
- During the conclave, ways to further boost defence and security cooperation among the member countries in the wake of evolving security challenges in the region were discussed.

Bajrang Punia becomes first Indian wrestler to fight at New York's Madison Square Garden

- Bajrang Punia became first Indian wrestler to be invited by American wrestling body for a special fight at iconic Madison Square Garden in New York, United States.
- Punia will take on two-time US national champion Yianni Diakomahlis in "Grapple at the Garden" Beat the Streets fight night event, a major showcase platform for international wrestling since 2010.

Raheem Sterling named 2019 FWA footballer of the year

- Raheem Sterling has been named the 2019 footballer of the year by the Football Writers' Association (FWA).
- The Manchester City and England forward topped the poll of the 400-strong FWA membership as a clear winner, with 62 percent of the votes.

- International Dance Day is observed on 29 April, 2019.
- The message author of International Dance Day was Karima Mansour from Egypt.

International Jazz Day observed

- International Jazz Day is observed on 30 April, 2019.
- The 2019 edition of International Jazz Day, will be launched in Australia and will be celebrated in more than 190 countries around the world.

World's First floating nuclear power plant to begin operations

- Akademik Lomonosov, the world's only floating nuclear power unit is ready to start commercial operations in Russia.
- The plant was launched by Russia on May 19, 2018 at the St Petersburg shipyard.

- The power plant is ready to start generating power after a series of comprehensive and successful tests on its twin KLT-40 reactor system.

Justice P.R. Ramachandra Menon Appointed As New Chief Justice Of Chhattisgarh HC

- The President of India has appointed Kerala High Court Judge Justice P.R. Ramachandra Menon as Chief Justice Of Chhattisgarh High Court.
- The Supreme Court Collegium has recompensed the Government to appoint him as Chief Justice.

Global Food Policy Report-2019 released

- International Food Policy Research Institute (IFPRI) has recently released Global Food Policy Report-2019. IFPRI's flagship report reviews the major food policy issues, developments, and decisions of 2018, and considers challenges and opportunities for 2019.
- This year's Global Food Policy Report highlights the urgency of rural revitalization to address a growing crisis in rural areas. Food Policy report says that rural people around the world continue to struggle with food insecurity, persistent poverty and inequality, and environmental degradation.
- Drawing on recent findings, IFPRI researchers and other distinguished food policy experts consider critical aspects of rural revitalization. Rural population account for 45.3% of the world's total population and at least 70% of the world's population remains extremely poor.
- In addition, rural communities bear the brunt of climate change impacts. Nearly 50% of rural youth all over the world do not have any formal job they are either unemployed or under-employed.

Indian & French Navies conduct Varuna 19.1 Bilateral Exercise

- The Indo-French joint naval exercise, Varuna 19.1 began off the Goa coast on May 1, 2019.
- The exercise will conclude on May 10, 2019. This 17th edition includes participation of the French Navy's aircraft carrier FNS Charles de Gaulle, two destroyers FNS Forbin and FNS Provence, the frigate FNS Latouche-Treville, the tanker FNS Marne and a nuclear submarine.

UN designates Masood Azhar as Global Terrorist; China lifted its hold

- The 1267 Al-Qaida Sanctions Committee of the United Nations Security Council on May 1, 2019 designated Pakistan's Jaish-e-Mohammad (JeM) chief Masood Azhar as a Global Terrorist.
- With the addition of Azhar to the Al-Qaida Sanctions List, he will be subject to the assets freeze, travel ban and arms embargo. The Sanctions List currently contains the names of 262 individuals and 83 entities.

World Press Freedom Day-2019 celebrated

- The 26th celebration of World Press Freedom Day is jointly organized by UNESCO on 3 May, 2019, the African Union Commission and the Government of the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia.
- The main event has taken place in Addis Ababa, on May 03, 2019 at the African Union Headquarters.
- This year's theme is – "Media for Democracy: Journalism and Elections in Times of Disinformation"- discusses current challenges faced by media in elections, along with the media's potential in supporting peace and reconciliation processes.

ApurviChandela becomes world number 1 in 10m air rie, Anjum claims second position

- India's ApurviChandela on May 1, 2019 became world number 1 in women's 10m air rifle event, according to the latest rankings released by the International Shooting Sport Federation.
- Hailing from Jaipur, the shooting ace is among the five Indian shooters to have already secured 2020 Olympics quotas for the country.

- The shooter took to twitter to share her joy on achieving the feat. “World Number 1 touched a milestone in my shooting career,” wrote Chandela.

Shooters Heena Sidhu, Ankur Mittal recommended for Rajiv Gandhi Khel Ratna Award

- The National Shooting Federation on April 29, 2019 recommended pistol ace Heena Sidhu and trap shooter Ankur Mittal for the 2019 Rajiv Gandhi Khel Ratna Award, the country’s highest sporting honour.
- Heena Sidhu is the first Indian pistol shooter to reach number one in the International Shooting Sport Federation (ISSF) world rankings. She has won multiple gold medals at the World Cup, Commonwealth Games, Commonwealth and Asian Championships.

ISRO planning to send a probe to study sun in 2020

- The Indian Space Research Organization is planning to send a probe to study the sun early in 2020. The information was shared by ISRO chairman Dr K Sivan, who said that currently scientists are exploring possibilities to study more about Sun and the probe named Aditya-L1 will be sent to observe the solar corona, the outer layers of the Sun.
- The satellite would be in a halo orbit around the L1 (Lagrangian point 1) of the SunEarth system so that it has the advantage of continuously viewing the Sun without any occultation or eclipses. The L1 is 1.5 million kms from the Earth.

ISRO to launch radar imaging satellite ‘RISAT 2BR1’

- India is planning to launch its latest radar imaging satellite RISAT 2BR1 towards the end of May 2019 on one of the variants of the Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle (PSLV) rocket. The satellite, RISAT 2BR1, is expected to be launched aboard one of the reusable PSLV rockets on May 22, as per officials of the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO).

INS VELA submarine to be launched for trials

- INS Vela, a Scorpene class submarine will be launched for trials on May 6, 2019. The submarine will be launched by Secretary (Defence Production) at the Mazagon Dockyards Limited (MDL).

Former ISRO Chairman awarded France’s Highest Civilian Honour

- Former ISRO chairman A S Kiran Kumar was on May conferred with France’s highest civilian honour, Chevalier de l’Ordre national de la Legion d’Honneur, for his contribution to India-France space cooperation.
- Kumar was conferred with the prestigious honour by France’s Ambassador to India Alexandre Ziegler on behalf of the French President.

Almost half of World Heritage sites could lose their glaciers by 2100

- Glaciers are set to disappear completely from almost half of World Heritage sites if business-as-usual emissions continue, according to the first-ever global study of World Heritage glaciers, co-authored by scientists from the International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN).
- The sites are home to some of the world’s most iconic glaciers, such as the Grosser Aletschgletscher in the Swiss Alps, Khumbu Glacier in the Himalayas or Greenland’s JakobshavnIsbrae.

RBI directs banks to enhance housing loan limits for eligibility under priority sector lending

- Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has directed banks to enhance the housing loan limits for eligibility under priority sector lending (PSL) to Rs 35 lakh in metropolitan centres (with a population of ten lakh and above) and Rs 25 lakh in other centres.
- In order to bring the RRBs and SFBs at a level playing field with other Scheduled Commercial Banks, it has now been decided to enhance the housing loan limits for eligibility under PSL.
- Accordingly, in respect of RRBs and SFBs, housing loans to individuals up to Rs 35 lakh in metropolitan centres (with population of ten lakh and above) and Rs 25 lakh in other centres, provided the overall cost of the dwelling unit in the metropolitan centres and at other centres

does not exceed Rs 45 lakh and Rs 30 lakh, respectively, will be eligible for classification under PSL.

Ratan Tata invests in Ola Electric Mobility

- Ratan Tata, the Chairman Emeritus of Tata Sons, invested in Ola Electric Mobility (OEM), the electric vehicle business of cab aggregator Ola. However, the details of the investment were not disclosed.
- Tata is also an early investor in ANI Technologies, Ola's parent company. He had invested in ANI Technologies in July 2015. In March 2019, the Ola Electric Mobility had raised Rs 400 crore in a funding round led by Tiger Global and Matrix India.

Piramal, CPPIB in tie-up for India's 1st renewables InvIT

- Piramal Enterprises Ltd on said it has signed an agreement with Canada's largest pension fund manager, Canada Pension Plan Investment Board (CPPIB), to co-sponsor India's first renewable energy-focused infrastructure investment trust (InvIT).
- The proposed InvIT will have an initial targeted corpus of up to \$600 million with an option to scale up further, Piramal said in a regulatory filing. CPPIB and Piramal will initially allocate \$360 million and \$90 million, respectively, to the corpus.

Sushma Swaraj to attend Shanghai Cooperation Organisation meeting

- External Affairs Minister Sushma Swaraj will attend the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation Council of Foreign Ministers meeting in Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan later in May 2019.
- The meeting will also be attended by Pakistan's Foreign Minister Shah Mehmood Qureshi.
- The two-day Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) meeting will conclude on May 22, 2019, a day ahead of announcement of the Lok Sabha Election 2019 results.

Centre announces assistance of Rs 1,000 cr for cyclone hit Odisha

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi has announced a further release of Rs 1,000 Crore for assistance to the Fani affected state Odisha .
- Earlier Rs 341 crores had been provided to Odisha as an advance to its State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF). Prime Minister also announced Rs. 2 lakh ex-gratia each for the family member of dead in the natural disaster and Rs. 50,000 for the injured.

Zero pendency court project by Delhi high court

- Delhi High Court has recently released a report that talks about the problem of increasing backlog and pendency of cases. Prompted by the urgent need to ensure timely justice, the Delhi High Court started a Pilot Project titled "Zero Pendency Courts" in certain subordinate courts in Delhi.
- The primary goal of the project was to study the flow of cases in the absence of backlog.
- The conclusions from this project would help in identifying benchmarks for different types of cases time lines, number of judges, case flow management rules and a host of other relevant factors.

World Asthma Day 2019 observed globally

- The World Asthma Day was observed across the globe on May 7, 2019, the first Tuesday of May 2019. The day is observed across the world to spread awareness about Asthma and its care around the world. The theme of World Asthma Day 2019 was 'STOP for Asthma'.
